




## SwapStream (Team No. 5)



## Description & Purpose


- For our project we created a web application that seamlessly integrates various music streaming platforms

- •Our project results in solving the problem of having to utilize multiple streaming sites and allows users to listen to their music in a faster and more streamlined manner




## Design
